

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

ANSON JONES LODGE #1416

This scholarship is intended only for high school seniors who will have graduated from an accredited institution or degree plan between January 1st and July 31st of the academic year preceding their enrollment in an institution of higher education. Accredited institutions include, but are not limited to high schools, approved home school programs, and private institutions (e.g., Friendswood High School, Lutheran South Academy, etc.). Priority will be given to those who are attending an accredited institution residing within the Friendswood Independent School District.

The following should be completed using this application form (pages 2-6):

1. A listing of statistics, school attended, jobs held, and all other relevant information.
2. Evidence of enrollment, or intent to enroll, in an accredited college or university of higher education for the current or subsequent academic year. Be aware that trade or vocational school enrollment does not qualify for this scholarship.
3. A brief essay regarding goals and intended major, which should include all instances of community service and volunteerism, as well as any jobs and/or extracurricular activities that establish the student's needs and why they are deserving of a scholarship.

The following should be included along with this application when submitted:

1. Two (2) letters of recommendations, which may be acquired from teachers, employers, counselors, or any other person who can speak to the student's drive, determination, and desire to succeed.
2. A copy of the student's high school transcript reflecting a minimum GPA of 2.5 based on 4.0 grading system or comparable performance on other systems.

Additionally, I affirm that I will proceed with deliberate care to graduate.
2. Understand that this scholarship, if awarded, will be paid to the school in which I enroll and that the award is for one academic year only. Failure to use the award within one academic year of date of issuance will result in its forfeiture and return to Anson Jones Masonic Lodge.
3. Understand that this application must be accompanied by the following for the application to be considered in full. If this application is to be sent by post instead of via electronic submission, the following must be included in one (1) envelope:
 - a. Two (2) letters of recommendation acquired from teachers, employers, counselors, or any other person who can speak to the applicant's drive, determination, and desire to succeed.
 - i. One (1) must be from a non-school related adult who personally knows the applicant. Examples include, but are not limited to, ministers, employers, and scout leaders.
 - ii. One (1) must be from a teacher with whom the student has studied.
 - b. An official copy of the student's current high school transcripts. If possible, they should be mailed in a sealed envelope directly from the school. Otherwise, they should be included in the one envelope mentioned above.
 - c. Additional documentation pertaining to awards, achievements, or distinctions earned that may be pertinent in the scholarship selection process may also be provided. However, such documentation is not required.
4. Authorize all schools I have attended to furnish the scholarship selection committee with any information that they may have regarding my academic career within any applicable legal and/or institutional parameters, as bound by state and federal law.
